

The Daisy Cavalli Scholarship Fund benefits graduating seniors who attend a Napa Valley Unified School District high school and will be enrolling in a trade school, community college, or four-year college/university. Recipients will receive funding for each year that they are enrolled as a full-time student.

Award Amount: \$5,000 per year.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION IS MARCH 11, 2019

WHO'S ELIGIBLE

- Graduating high school seniors who attend a Napa Valley Unified School District high school: American Canyon High School, Napa High School, New Tech High School, Napa Valley Independent Studies, Valley Oak High School or Vintage High School
- Candidates must:
 - be in good academic standing
 - have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.0
 - be planning to attend a trade/vocational college or a two- or four-year college/university pursuing undergraduate studies
 - demonstrate financial need
 - participate in community service
- Preference given to first generation college students (i.e. neither parent has obtained a Bachelor's Degree)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Completed online application
- 500 word essay "What are your educational and career goals for college, and if you are the first person in your family to attend college, please tell us why attending college is important to you?"
- List the community service activities in which you have been involved, the number of hours per week you devote to these activities and the roles and responsibilities you performed.
- A copy of your unofficial transcript
- A copy of the page from your FAFSA Student Aid Report or California Dream Act Student Aid Report showing your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)- *if applicable*
- One academic letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or administrator
