Emerging Environmental Leaders Scholarship 2026 Guidelines

The <u>Emerging Environmental Leaders Scholarship</u> benefits Napa County high school seniors and Napa Valley Community College students who are passionate about protecting the environment and improving their community. Applicant must be highly motivated, thoughtful, and taking early steps—big or small—toward climate action. Recipients must be planning to pursue a college degree at a community college or four-year college/university. Recipients of the scholarship will receive funding for up to four years while working to complete their undergraduate degree.

Award Amount: \$2,500 per year for up to four years (\$10,000 total)

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION IS MARCH 2, 2026

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

- Graduating high school seniors who attend a high school in Napa County
- Current Napa Valley Community College students

ALL APPLICANTS MUST:

demonstrate financial need

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- > be in good academic standing
- be participating in one or more school-based or nonprofit environmental/climate clubs/organizations (such as but not limited to the Napa Sierra Club Internship Program and Napa Schools for Climate Action)
- ➤ have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.0
- be planning to attend an accredited, non-profit, two-year or four-year college/university pursuing undergraduate studies in majors (like science or political science) that prepare them to be leaders in the fight against climate change

1.	What major are you pursuing and why have you chosen this major?
