Understanding the Support Offered

What is a Health-Related Emergency?

• A long-term illness or acute medical condition not covered, or not fully covered, by the employee's health or LTD insurance, which creates an undue financial hardship for the employee.

What is a Disaster-Related Emergency?

• An earthquake, fire, flood or other disaster that damages or destroys the employee's primary residence, and/or the contents in that residence, which creates an undue financial hardship for the employee.

What Mental Health support is available?

• The Mental Health Program provides funding to pay for therapy sessions for employees and qualified family members when treatment is not covered by insurance or workers' comp, or is being paid for by the employee out-of-pocket. Up to 20 sessions per year can be covered.

Application Process

• Applications from qualified employees will be evaluated quickly and objectively. While every application will receive due consideration, funding is not guaranteed.
